2020 Summer Camp Policies

PAYMENT POLICIES

REGISTRATION: Tuition for the camp program is \$337 per whole-day camp and \$172 per half-day camp. Additional discounts may be available. The tuition and application deadline is May 18, 2020 for June camps and July 6, 2020 for July camps. A \$75 non-refundable deposit is due at time of registration. The remaining balance is due May 18, 2020 for June camps and July 6, 2020 for July camps. Late payment of fees will result in a \$25 late fee. Non-payment of fees will result in the child not participating in the program.

REGISTRATION CANCELLATION: Cancellations 15 or more days before camp will result in a full refund, minus the \$75 registration fee. Cancellations 8-14 days before camp will result in 50% of total cost of camp refund. Cancellations 1-7 days before camp will result in 0% refund. Protection insurance is available for purchase at registration that will provide additional refunds.

RESERVATIONS: A participant's spot is only held with a completed application and full tuition payment.

NON-SUFFICIENT FUNDS: All payments are paid by credit card. In the case where a check is accepted, if the check or credit card payment is returned Non-Sufficient Funds (NSF), it may be re-presented electronically, and there will be a processing fee of \$30.00. This must be paid before a participant may attend camp. The parent/guardian is responsible for all other check recovery costs, including all attorney's fees, court costs and taxes. In the event of a NSF check, remaining balances must be paid in certified funds.

MISSED DAYS: WhizKids does not credit accounts for missed days. The parent/guardian is responsible for fees even though the participant may not participate in the full week of programming by choice, illness, or while suspended from the WhizKids camp program.

CAMP CANCELLATIONS: WhizKids Programs LLC reserves the right to cancel any camp that does not reach or maintain a minimum number of participants or for other unforeseen circumstances. In the case of camp cancellations, participants will be notified with as much warning as possible so that one of the following can be done:

(1)Transfer full tuition to another date or location (no change fee); (2)Receive a full refund (minus the 3.5% card processing fee); (3)Receive a voucher for next summer (transferrable to family and friends).

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS AND AGREEMENTS

SIGN IN/SIGN OUT: Participants must be signed in and out of camp daily by a person indicated on the participant's registration form. Participants can be signed in as early as 7:30 a.m. and signed out as late as 4:30 p.m. each day of camp for no additional charge. If a participant is signed out after 4:30 p.m., an additional \$1 per minute will be charged (to be paid at time of pick up). Before and after camp times (7:30-8:30 a.m.; 3:30-4:30 p.m.), participants will not be doing curriculum-related activities. Participants are not to be left at the WhizKids location before the sign-in table/kiosk has been set up and a WhizKids staff member is there to receive and supervise participants.

LUNCH AND SNACKS: Parent/guardian will send a lunch and drink each day with the participant. WhizKids provides a morning and afternoon snack, and special arrangements are not to be made unless there is a medical condition that prevents a participant from eating a certain food. Should a participant have an allergy to a particular food item or a condition that prevents the participant from eating particular foods, a written doctor's statement indicating the nature of the allergy/condition and a listing of foods that are to be avoided should be provided to WhizKids two (2) weeks prior to camp. In this case, WhizKids will not offer alternative snacks, but snacks may be provided by parent/guardian. When a participant has an extreme allergic reaction, a medical alert bracelet should be worn by the participant at all times (provided by the parent/guardian). WhizKids will not alter snack/meal patterns based on the personal preference/tastes of the parent and/or participant.

PHOTO AND VIDEO RELEASE: The option is given during registration to give or deny permission for any photographs and/or videos taken during the course of the WhizKids program to appear in any media. Furthermore, in the event that the parent/guardian or participant is asked to comment on the program, permission is granted to WhizKids Programs LLC to use the quote for promotional purposes.

COMMUNICATION: Notes, emails, and the WhizKids Programs Facebook and Instagram pages are the typical forms of communication used. Most of the emails are mass emails, so the parent/guardian should check Junk and Spam folders, and add WhizKids, MailChimp, and EasyReg to their contacts. The WhizKids office should be notified if emails are not being received. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to

contact WhizKids with any information that needs to be updated (i.e. billing info, address change, new email address, etc.)

LOST, DAMAGED, OR STOLEN ITEMS: WhizKids is not responsible for any items that are lost, damaged, or stolen at camp. Participants' names should be marked on all clothing, backpacks, etc. Participants may not bring toys, phones, iPods, electronic games, or other such items unless requested by the teacher. Parent/guardian is responsible for any damages the participant causes to WhizKids property and/or Location facilities.

SUNSCREEN: According to the Mississippi State Department of Health, sunscreen is considered a medication. Participants will spend time outside daily, so application should be done by the parent/guardian before camp if they feel that the participant is in danger of burning. Sunscreen should also be sent with the participant if believed that additional application is needed.

SELF-ADMINISTRATION OF PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION: In order for a participant to self-administer prescription medications, the Authorization for Self-Administration of Prescription Medication form should be requested by the parent, completed fully, and authorized by a licensed health care professional. All prescription medications, including medications for conditions such as food, drug, or insect allergies; diabetes; asthma; or epilepsy may be brought to WhizKids under the condition that forms are completed as indicated above and the participant can self-manage care and delivery of medication.

MEDICAL TREATMENT, CONSENT, & LIABILITY: WhizKids does not provide insurance for participants in its program, and it is the parent/guardian's responsibility to provide for medical/dental insurance and/or expenses. The parent/guardian grants permission for their son/daughter/ward to receive necessary medical treatment and gives their permission to WhizKids staff to seek treatment for said participant, in the event of an injury or illness while participating in the WhizKids programs. Furthermore, the parent/guardian accepts responsibility for full payment of such medical treatment. The parent/guardian holds WhizKids and its representatives harmless in the exercise of this authority.

BEHAVIOR: Participants are expected to behave appropriately. It is the goal of WhizKids to ensure that each child has an enjoyable and fulfilling experience. WhizKids will always emphasize positive ways to deal with difficult situation. Our policies on discipline include verbal warnings, one-on-one discussions, time outs, parent/guardian

conversations, and possible removal from the program. Bullying, dangerous play, and violence will not be tolerated.

TERMINATION: WhizKids may terminate a participant's enrollment for any of the following reasons: Emergency names and phone numbers are incorrect; Parent/guardian is repeatedly late picking up participant ; Repeated Non/late/NSF payment of fees; Behavior that is continually disruptive or dangerous to others and/or self; Behavior that is destructive to property and/or refusal to replace said property; Any single incident that is deemed by the Founder to be dangerous, harmful or disruptive; Harassment, violent behavior or threat of such behaviors against a staff person or other member by parent/guardian or persons associated to the participant (family member, family friend, etc.).

WAIVER OF LIABILITY, DISCLAIMER, & PERMISSIONS

You forever release, acquit, discharge and agree to indemnify and hold harmless WhizKids Programs LLC and all event sponsors and volunteers, as well as any officers, directors, agents, employees, successors or assigns of the aforementioned parties, in addition to all other persons who are either directly, or indirectly involved with the activity in which the participant is registering (collectively the "Released Parties"), from any and all liabilities, claims, damages and demands and all other liabilities or whatever kind of nature arising from or related to WhizKids Programs LLC activity, including, but not limited to, any and all liabilities, claims damages and demands arising from any personal injuries, loss or death occurring as a result of WhizKids Programs LLC activity. You further agree that you will never institute any action or suit, at law, in equity or otherwise, against any of the Released Parties, and will not aid in the institution or prosecution of any such action or suit against the Released Parties which in any way involves or relates to WhizKids activity. You further state that participant is in proper medical condition to participate in and complete WhizKids Programs LLC activities and is not participating against doctor's advice, nor is participant taking medications which would deter participant's health in the participation of WhizKids activity. If any act of God forces the cancellation of WhizKids activity, you understand that registration fees are non-refundable. This Release shall be binding upon the executors, administrators, personal representatives, heirs, successors and assigns of the undersigned.
